- We do not allow the public display of tattoos, multiple ear piercing or body piercing. Men may not wear earrings while they are at camp.
- Appropriate, conservative attire at all times while at camp. We do not allow 2 piece bathing suits, inappropriate t-shirts or tattered and unkept clothing.
- You will wear a hat or hairnet and appropriate foot wear while in the kitchen.
- There will be no borrowing or using someone else's things with out their permission.
- Boys and girls are not allowed in each others cabins or alone with each other around camp.
- You will respect and obey your counselors at all times.
- Foul language, bad attitude and lazy work habits will not tolerated.
- Other rules will be covered during orientation
