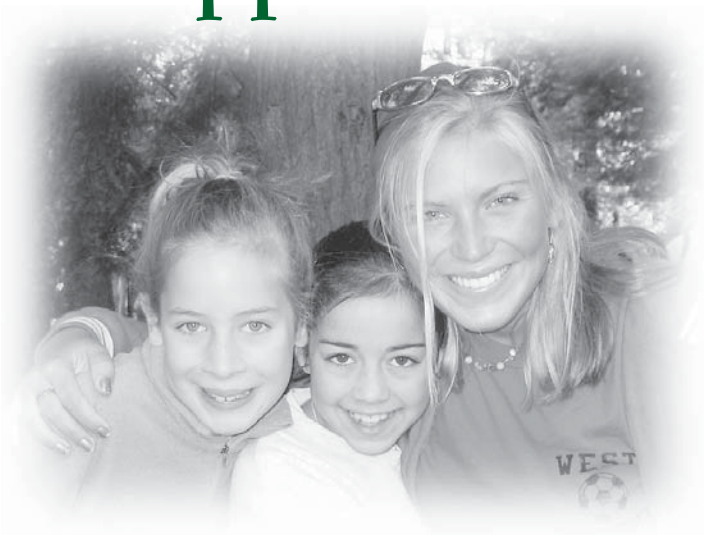


# Camp Greystone Staff Application

We help girls develop full and satisfying lives through significant summer experiences in an uplifting Christian environment. Most important to this development is nurturing in them a strong faith and personal relationship with Jesus Christ. The Bible gives us the true and certain path to this faith and relationship.

**OUR PURPOSE...**is to do all that we can to help each girl develop balanced lives through the conscious development of four aspects of life: the physical, mental, social, and spiritual. The person who works (but does not obsess) on these four areas will reap the rewards of a significant life.

## THE DO'S AND DON'TS



It is our policy to “act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with our God” (Micah 6:8). In order to create a community of trust and

love, it is essential that we believe in the word of God and strongly uphold its doctrine. We ask that our staff exemplify these ideals in attitude, action, and speech.

While under contract, our staff does not condone, nor personally use drugs, tobacco or alcohol. This includes the appearance of impropriety (i.e. going to parties or hanging out with groups who are using these substances).

It is vital that staff members' conduct always reflect their faith. We ask that you be able to represent the Christian lifestyle with a positive attitude and wholesome speech.

You will love that, when working at Greystone, you are among a staff that is like-minded, loyal to you, and excited about this ministry. The Greystone community is refreshingly bright because we all work together toward common goals of integrity, loyalty, honesty, kindness and truth.

## CAMP LIFE

You may expect time off during each session as follows:

June Camp	1 day
Main Camp	3 days
August Camps	1/2 day

Days off begin after breakfast and end at midnight.

Camp is located in a beautiful part of the country, and your days off are the perfect time to explore the area.



## MEN STAFF

As a man in a predominantly female environment, we rely on you to be a positive role model and a selfless support to the community. Men do not assume a counseling ministry, although many do choose to teach a Sunday School class. We hire men in all areas of camp and count on your strength of

character AND body (i.e. moving trunks, beds, sweeping the dining room after meals, etc...). Men should be prepared to give selflessly of their time and energy to accomplish the seen and unseen tasks of a large group.



## GENERAL APPEARANCE

Modesty of dress should be considered at all times. Brief bathing suits and T-shirts with inappropriate images or fraternity/sorority party shirts should be left at home.

Men should be clean shaven and have hair neatly cut above the collar. Men may not wear earrings while they are at camp.

We do not allow the public display of tattoos, multiple ear piercing, or body piercing.
